Margaret is the Director of Outreach and Widening Participation at WMG, University of Warwick, where she leads initiatives to inspire and engage young people in STEM. Her team delivers interactive workshops, presentations, and hands-on activities, making STEM accessible and exciting for all. She has developed a range of innovative, creative, cross-curricular projects, including [Stitch in Time](#), [Engaging Young People with Assistive Technologies through 3D Printing and CAD](#), and [STEM Connections](#). In 2008, Margaret founded the Technology Volunteers Project, empowering students to lead Scratch programming workshops in local schools.
